



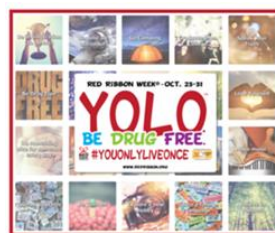
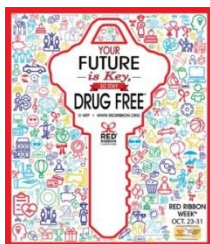
ENTER THE COMMUNITY CELEBRATION ART SHOW!!

- 4 "Best Overall" Prize Classes: Elementary (Grades K-2 & 3-5), Middle and High School.
- Entries should include a Red Ribbon in the design. The actual ribbon should be a double looped ribbon or bow, as opposed to a single loop.
- While the red ribbon should be prominently featured in the design, don't be afraid to use other colors, as well.
- Medium: Artists choice – painting, drawing, collage, photography, digital, etc.
- **Themes should be brief and as catchy as possible.** 2017 theme is "Your Future Is Key, So Stay Drug Free." Prior year themes are shown below.
